We are writing to invite you to the Surrey Age Group Championships to be held on February 5<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> March 06. A Development Gala has been added for the 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> February 06. As you may know, the Championships will continue as a joint event including the London Region and Surrey Southeast Region clubs.

The core programme has remained within three weekends. We have scheduled the Mixed 1500m Freestyle as a stand-alone event to be held at Aldershot Garrison Centre on Sunday, February 5<sup>th</sup>. We have included Disability swimming for all events and Skins races for 50m Freestyle.

In order to streamline the entry process, swimmers will not be required to fill out the individual and team entry form. Entries will only be accepted by e-mail. Information will be entered directly through a programme. It can be obtained by following the instructions included with this packet. He can answer questions you may have about how to enter the data for your club. If your club requires another format for entering data, ie, CD or via the internet, please let Alan know.

A printout of your entries is required. The closing date is midnight, 31 December 2005. All secretaries' addresses are required for further contact so please fill in the competition secretary's information. As there is no individual or team entry form, only the club secretary is required to sign on behalf of all the swimmers. Please note there are no qualifying times for disability swimmers.

**Ages are as on last day of the Competition, i.e. 5 March 2006 and 9 years on 5 March 2006.** There will be no DCT events this year.

Coach passes will be £25 for the entire Championships. The number of poolside coaches remains at four. Daily passes are £5 per day and **we urge you to consider this option particularly on relay day**, when the number of swimmers and their safety on poolside is a priority. We will be monitoring numbers and may request you purchase additional passes on the day. Entry fees are £4 per event and £6 per team.

Please read the Promoter's Conditions carefully.

Clubs are encouraged to provide non-technical Officials. Please do so and advise Mrs. Joan Swain, 13 Gatley Drive, Guildford, Surrey, GU4 7JJ.
